Construction Activities - December 29, 2014 and January 3, 2015

No planned nighttime closures

As part of the Riverside County Transportation Commission's 91 Project in Corona and Riverside, there are no planned nighttime closures on the 91 and 15 from Monday, December 29, 2014 to Saturday, January 3, 2015. Daytime activities will continue to take place throughout the week except on Thursday, January 1, 2015.

As a reminder, crews are working weeknights from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. on Main Street and area streets near the 91. Utilities are being relocated to accommodate the lowering of Main Street beneath the 91 and making other local street improvements.

Lane reductions are taking place between East Grand Boulevard and Third Street. Cones are placed at night and picked up each morning before peak travel times. For future work on Main Street, long-term lane reductions will occur during daytime and nighttime hours, and work will take place behind K-rail.

NOTE: Information contained in the Construction Alert is subject to change without notice, based on weather, field conditions or other operational factors.

Buena Vista undercrossing at the 91 - Intermittent lane closure for utility work	Mon., Dec. 29 - Wed., Dec. 31, Fri., Jan 2 - 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.	No detour necessary as other lane will remain open.

Safety is RCTC's highest priority, so please:

- Slow down and watch for workers and heavy equipment
- Allow extra time to get to work, school or appointments
- Tell friends or customers about construction activity
- Be extra careful when driving at night and in rainy weather
- Avoid mobile phone use or other distractions when driving through this area
- Watch for lane and ramp closures, use alternate routes and follow detours
- Obey the "Move Over" Law, which requires you to move to lanes away from any construction work, when it's safe to do so
- Remember that this is a short-term inconvenience for long-term mobility benefits
