Inquiries along with responses may be posted at the website only when the inquiries are submitted in any of the acceptable manner prescribed under the Notice to the Contractors and when the responses have already been communicated to the individual inquirers. Bidders' inquiries received over the phone must be followed-up and submitted in writing for an official response.

The Bidders' inquiries and Responses may be updated from time to time and bidders are enjoined to check the website regularly and immediately prior to the scheduled bid opening.

Include the item total in your total bid. The Special Provisions describe the requirements and payment for the Small Business Utilization Report</p> |
| 2.0 | <p>Special_Provisions_Specific: "Waste from removal of yellow thermoplastic traffic stripe and pavement marking contains lead chromate in average concentrations greater than or equal to 5 mg/L Soluble Lead or 1,000 mg/kg Total Lead. Yellow thermoplastic traffic stripe and pavement marking exist from PM 72.1 to PM 87.9." - Section 10-1.15 p.38</p> <p>"Traffic stripe and pavement marking shall be removed at the locations shown on the plans..." - Section 10-1.15 p.38</p> <p>Question_2: There is no item in the bid schedule for removal of yellow thermoplastic traffic stripe. In addition, on plan sheet PDQ-1 in the pavement delineation quantities there are no quantities shown for removal of 4" yellow traffic stripe. Will the yellow centerline stripe be removed? If it is to be removed, how will the removal and disposal be paid??</p> <p>Response: There is no item for removal of thermoplastic traffic stripe. This item was overlooked and will be addressed by a Contract Change Order during construction. Do not include the cost of such work in your bid.</p> |
