Inquiries along with responses may be posted at the website only when the inquiries are submitted in any of the acceptable manner prescribed under the Notice to the Contractors and when the responses have already been communicated to the individual inquirers. Bidders' inquiries received over the phone must be followed-up and submitted in writing for an official response.

The Bidders' inquiries and Responses may be updated from time to time and bidders are enjoined to check the website regularly and immediately prior to the scheduled bid opening.

1.0	<p>Question_1: Will Caltrans consider an extension to the deadline of no less than one week?</p> <p>Response: If referring to Bid Opening Date. There will no extension and Bid will open as scheduled.</p>
1.1	<p>Question_1.1: Provided that the extension is granted, will Caltrans schedule a site visit for Mansfield?</p> <p>Response: Refer to question_1.0 for BOD. Site visits can be arranged by contacting Armand Silva at 951-314-3606.</p>
2.0	<p>Question_2: Section 4 notes completion of work expected within 60 working days, but Special Notices states that the contract award period has been extended for this project. Can you clarify the expected completion timeline?</p> <p>Response: This contract has a delayed start of 60 calendar days between the time the contract is approved (by Attorney General to start work) and the first working day. Then there are 60 actual working days to complete the project.</p>
2.1	<p>Question_2.1: If the expected completion timeline is less than 180 working days, will Caltrans consider the completion period to be 180 working days as standard industry lead time for equipment is 10-14 weeks upon order? .</p> <p>Response: Please refer to Section 3 and Section 8 of the Standard Specifications for definitions of award and execution of contract, definition of working day, and time of completion. Please refer to response 2.0 regarding the 60 calendar days start</p>
