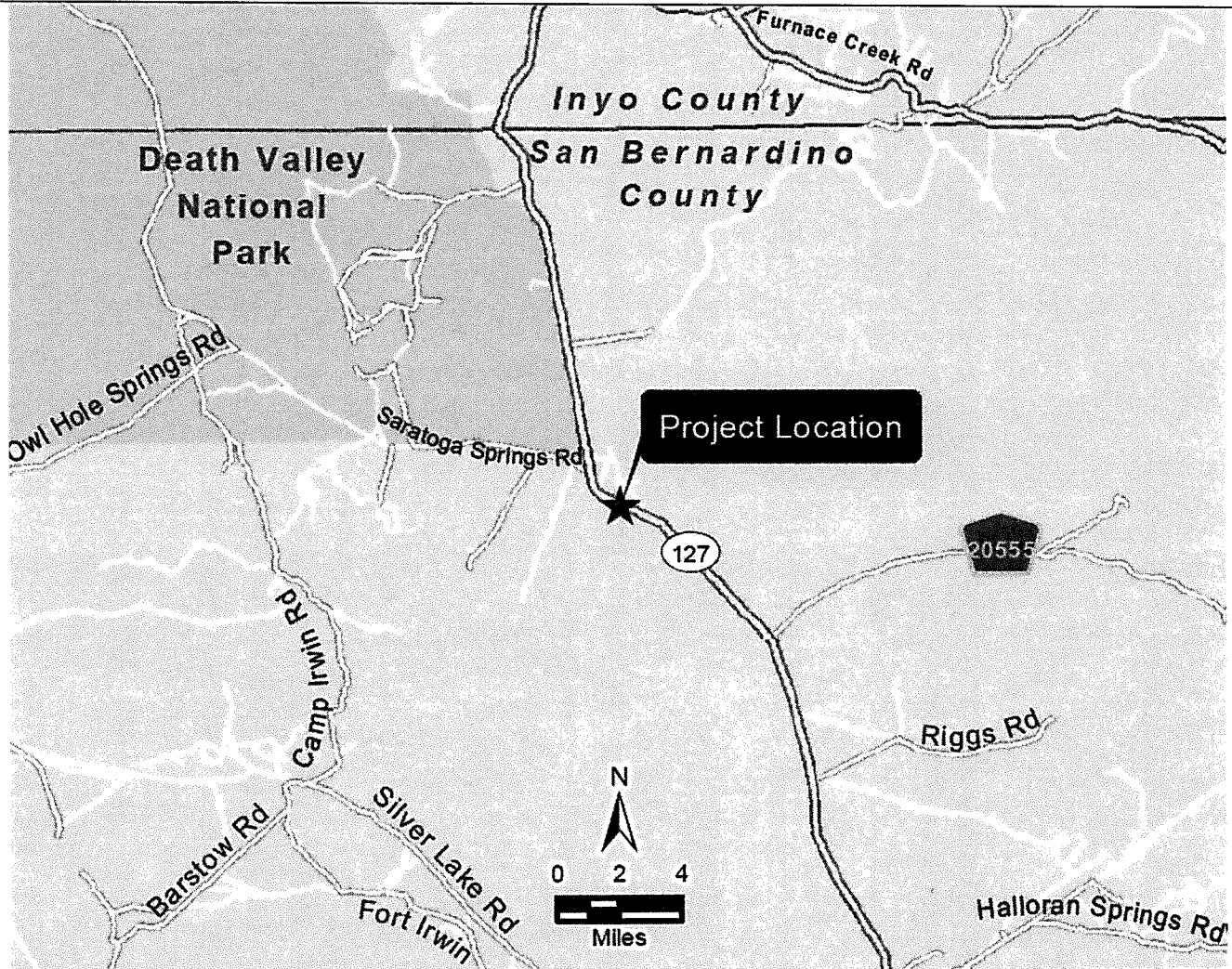

## Notice of Availability of an Environmental Assessment

### State Route 127 Shoulder Widening and Rumble Strips Project

| <p><b>WHAT'S BEING PLANNED</b></p> | <p>The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) plans to construct 8-foot wide shoulders, install 12-inch wide rumble strips along the shoulders in each direction, and centerline of State Route 127 (SR-127) from post mile (PM) 28.0 to 28.5 in an unincorporated area of San Bernardino County, California. Light grading is also included to accommodate the shoulder widening, while providing flatter 4:1 ratio slopes.</p>  |
| <p><b>WHY THIS AD?</b></p>         | <p>Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an <i>Environmental Assessment</i>. This notice is to tell you of the preparation of the <i>Environmental Assessment</i> and of its availability for you to read, and to also offer you the opportunity to request a public hearing/meeting, or to provide comments.</p>   |
