

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Department) proposes to Re-grade Median Cross Slopes inside the clear recovery zone from existing 6:1 or steeper gradients in the direction of 20:1 to 10:1 or flatter, drainage improvements & modifications in the median. Preserving and improving the existing California Highway Patrol (CHP) crossovers on Interstate 40 (I-40) from Junction 15/40 post mile 0.0 (PM 0.0) to 1.4 mile east of Fort Cady Road Overcrossing post mile 25.0 (PM R25.0) in San Bernardino County.

WHY THIS AD?

The Department has studied the effects this proposed project may have on the environment. The results are detailed in the Initial Studies (with proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration). This notice is to advise of the availability of this document for review and comment and intent to adopt this Mitigated Negative Declaration.
