SR 78 CLOSED FOR RAILROAD REPAIRS NEAR BLYTHE

Riverside County – Caltrans reports that the Arizona California Railroad will be working to repair railroad tracks that cross SR 78 in the town of Ripley, California near the California/Arizona border. From 12 p.m. Monday, March 19 to approximately 6 p.m. Tuesday, March 20, Route 78 will be closed between 24th Ave. and 28th Ave.

Detour:

- If traveling south on SR 78 near I –10, take 24th Ave. and go east to De Frain Blvd. Go south on De Frain Blvd. to 28th Ave. and turn right (west). Proceed west on 28th Ave. to return to southbound SR 78.
- If traveling north on SR 78 from Imperial County toward Riverside County, turn right (east) on 28th Ave. Continue on 28th Ave. to De Frain Blvd. and turn left (north). Proceed north on De Frain Blvd. to 24th Ave. and turn left (west). Continue west on 24th Ave. to return to northbound SR 78.
