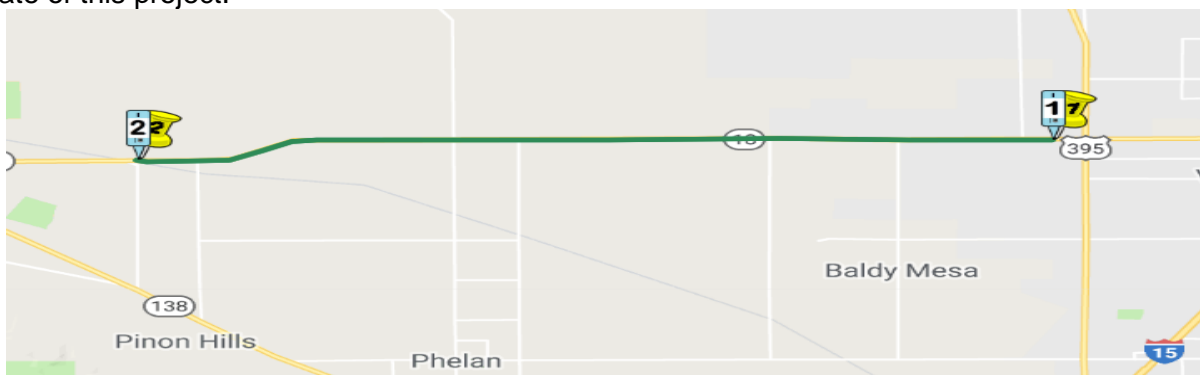

SHOULDER WIDENING PROJECT BEGINS ON SR-18 IN ADELANTO

SAN BERNARDINO— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a safety project on State Route 18 (SR-18) in and near the city of Adelanto from Route 395 (US-395) to 263rd East Street. The \$49 million project will include the widening of existing shoulders to the eight-foot state standard and the installation of centerline and shoulder rumble strips to reduce the severity of cross-centerline collisions. This construction project will begin in late April and continue through summer 2021.

During the project there will be alternating lane closures at various locations in both directions. Work will take place Monday – Thursday from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. and 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Fridays from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Motorists are advised that delays are expected through the work zone so please try and use alternate routes. Businesses will remain open and Caltrans will try and mitigate impacts to business access points as much as possible. Weather conditions may affect the completion date of this project.
