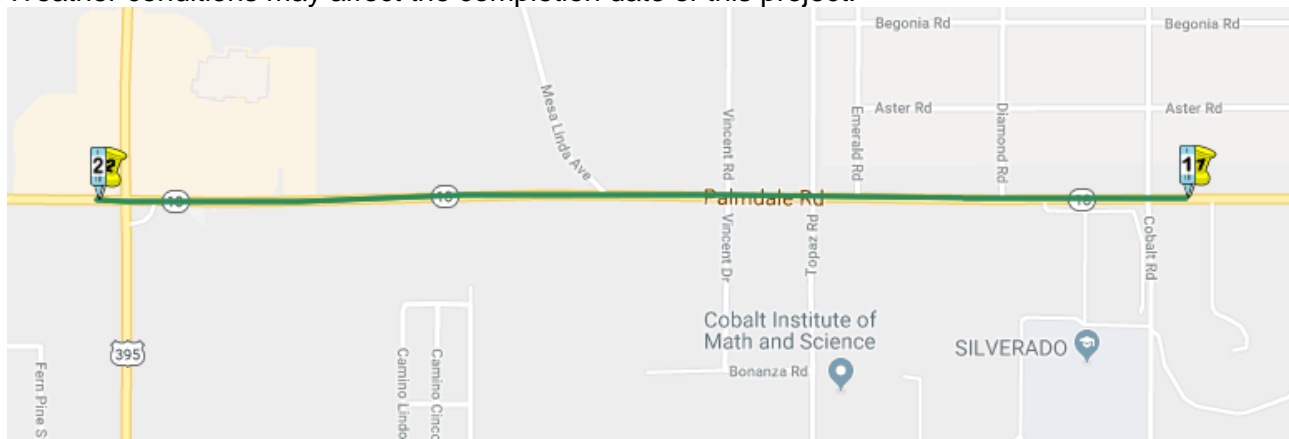

RAISED CURB MEDIAN PROJECT WILL BEGIN ON SR 18

SAN BERNARDINO— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a safety project on State Route 18 (SR-18) in Victorville from Cobalt Road to Route 95 (US-395). This \$15 million project will construct a raised curb median and include the reconfiguration of left turn pockets to enhance safety and help eliminate cross median collisions.

The project is expected to start the first week of May with construction taking place Monday – Friday from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m. with flagging.

Motorists are advised that delays are expected through the work zone so please use alternate routes. Businesses will remain open and Caltrans will try and mitigate impacts to business access points as much as possible. The project is expected to be complete in summer 2020. Weather conditions may affect the completion date of this project.
