NORTHBOUND I-215 CLOSURES at SR- 74 IN PERRIS- BRIDGE REPAIR PROJECT BEGINS

PERRIS – Construction starts Monday, June 25th and continues through Saturday morning, June 30th to repair the bridge that was damaged at this location during a traffic collision approximately two months ago. Skanska, Inc., the contractor on the \$300,000 emergency project, will be working from 10PM to 6AM, Monday through Friday. Caltrans has targeted five nights for repair and every effort will be made to accomplish the repairs in this time frame. Additional nights may be needed depending upon the extent of damage that will be evaluated during early stages of construction.

Northbound traffic will be reduced to one lane. Motorists will then be directed off and back on the freeway at the southbound SR-74 ramps. Keep traffic moving by merging early, allowing other vehicles to merge and adding time to your commute. Six CHP officers will be stationed in the project. Drivers are advised to take alternate routes.
