## **PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT**

**Friday, October 26, 2007**

The mandatory evacuation order for the community of Crestline is being reduced to voluntary, effective immediately.

Residents who live in the communities of Valley of Enchantment, Cedar Pines Park and Crestline will be allowed to re-enter their homes.

Checkpoints have been designated for the re-entry process at Wildwood Park located at 40th and Waterman, and Hwy 138 at the Cottonwood Ranger Station (just south of Lake Silverwood). The checkpoints will be opened from 0900 to midnight on Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup> and from 0900 to midnight on Saturday, October 27<sup>th</sup>. You will need to park your vehicle in the designated area and walk to the checkpoint to speak to a law enforcement representative at the information table. Residents must provide proof of residency to obtain a re-entry pass. Residents who do not obtain a pass prior to Sunday, October 28<sup>th</sup> will have to wait until Monday, October 29<sup>th</sup> to obtain a pass at the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department located at 655 E. Third Street during routine business hours. **PASSES WILL NOT BE ISSUED ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 28<sup>th</sup>.**
