STATE ROUTE 330 PROJECT COMPLETE **Mountain Route Open**

San Bernardino County – Caltrans is pleased to announce the completion of the State Route 330 (SR-330) slope rehabilitation project. The \$7.5 million project rebuilt three slopes that were damaged as a result of heavy storms in 2004. The project began in early August 2005. Sign removal for the project will continue through Friday, December 15.

Thousands of tons of earth were removed and then replaced to stabilize the downhill slopes. Rock retaining walls were built at the bottom of City Creek to act as a buffer to fast moving water during heavy rains. New drains were also put in place to minimize flooding and improve drainage. The contractor worked night and day and sometimes seven days a week to restore the damaged slopes.

Caltrans worked closely with the community and mountain businesses to minimize impacts to traffic during the expedited project, which called for intermittent closure of the route. Concerned Caltrans engineers prompted the shortened work schedule in order to preserve SR-330 before this winter.

Caltrans acknowledged the mountain residents and business owners for their continued support and patience at a recent thank you dinner in Running Springs. The Department would also like to thank the contractor, Vance Corporation, for their dedication and excellent service to the motorists during the entire project. Their cooperation made it possible for emergency service passage throughout the construction.
