Construction of the Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project

Riverside County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will host a public meeting to share information on construction of the Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project with local residents and business owners. The project includes repaving sections of Interstate 10 (I-10) and most of the freeway ramps in Calimesa and Beaumont, widening the westbound Beaumont off-ramp, replacing the eastbound 60 connector to eastbound I-10, upgrading metal beam guardrail, replacing concrete median barrier with higher barrier to reduce headlight glare, lowering the existing 6th Street off-ramp to provide more clearance for tall trucks, and upgrading drainage.

The meeting will be held at the time and place shown below:
