



PURPOSE AND NEED

- ▶ **Purpose:** Due to potential for structural failure, it is recommended that the left Watson Wash Bridge structure be replaced as soon as possible. In its present condition, the bridge requires monitoring to avert potential adverse impacts on the safety of the traveling public.
- ▶ **Need:** The left Watson Wash Bridge (Br. 54-0805L) is identified as having moderate to severe cracking deterioration in the deck, weakening the structure's strength. The proposed bridge would be designed to resist local environmental conditions to prevent this type of cracking.
