Install Double Thrie Beam Median Barrier

- **Purpose and Need:**
- The double thrie beam is expected to reduce the severity of collision and minimize the fatality rate due to cross median collisions and improper turns.
- The existing soft median barrier, by two sets of double yellow lines with rumble strips in between is not adequate for reducing the number of cross median collisions due to a combination of driver tendencies and physical environment.





This project is on Route 18 in San Bernardino County Between 0.02 miles north of southbound off ramp to Sierra Way to To Route 18/138 Separation




